## Hystorical view

- 03
- In 1914, Concordat was signed between the Kingdom of Serbia and the Holy See according to which the Archdiocese of Belgrade was established
- The area of today's Archdiocese is about 50,000 km2, covers the whole of Serbia without Vojvodina, and has about 40,000 believers. Pope John Paul II formed the Belgrade Metropolitan in 1986, which includes Roman Catholic Diocese of Zrenjanin and Subotica. The Bishops' Conference of Yugoslavia was formed in 1997, and it consisted of six bishops: Bishops of Zrenjanin, Subotica, Bar, Kotor, Prizren and the apostolic administrator of Belgrade, who was also the president of BC
- The Bishops' Conference in its current form was formed in 2001 as the International Bishops' Conference of Saints Cyril and Methodius, and it consists of the diocese of Serbia, Montenegro and Macedonia. The Archdiocese is divided into 16 parishes, six parishes in Belgrade, with the parishes in Valjevo, Šabac, Bor, Zaječar, Niš, Kraljevo, Kragujevac, Kruševac, Smederevo and Ravna Reka



## Hystorical view



- Msgr. Stanislav Hocevar takes the service of the Archbishop and Metropolitan of Belgrade on 31 March 2001
- Desiring to present the Belgrade Archdiocese in 2018 as a place of new initiatives for improvement of the interreligious, intercultural and social dialogue with significant highlighting of the modern Archdiocese' values, Archbishop Hocevar has launched a new integral project of repositioning of the Belgrade Archdiocese capital values
- Project activities, as a main goal, possess empowerment of the strategic position of the Belgrade Archdiocese, both in the domain of sustainability of the Archdiocese everyday functioning, and in the mission of achieving capital projects who have not had a chance to be implemented for several decades
- The positioning values which Belgrade Archdiocese wants to afforce are: cultural dimension, historiacal dimension, socially beneficial and economic dimensions
